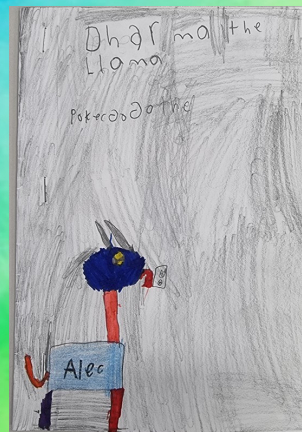
## Communicate
