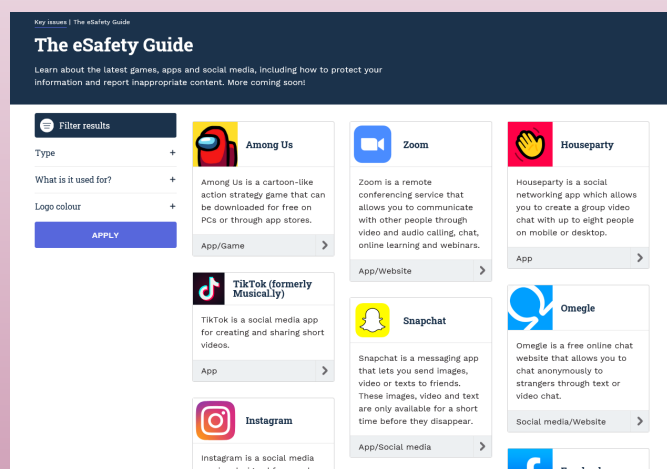

Hello Paradise Primary School Community,
I hope you are all keeping well.

Through many informative discussions with students, I am aware that many children at our school enjoy gaming online, through sites such as Roblox or Xbox online, and hold various social media accounts (**reminder: many of the 'popular' social media platforms require a minimum age of 13+ yrs**). While the online experience can be informative and entertaining, there are risks for children participating online that must be considered. The eSafety Commissioner website (www.eSafety.gov.au) provides a wealth of information about keeping safe online, including reporting abuse, the sharing of personal information etc. The site is user friendly and has sections targeted towards parents and children. The eSafety Guide provides a thorough breakdown of various social media platforms and gaming Apps. It is a good idea to familiarize yourself with the programs your children are using. Please take some time, with your children, to have a look at the site. An alarming fact you may not know is that once you post any image online (e.g. photos of yourself, friends etc.), you no longer hold the legal rights to those images and they can be accessed and shared by anyone. Knowing how to keep safe online is very important to protect yourself and your children.

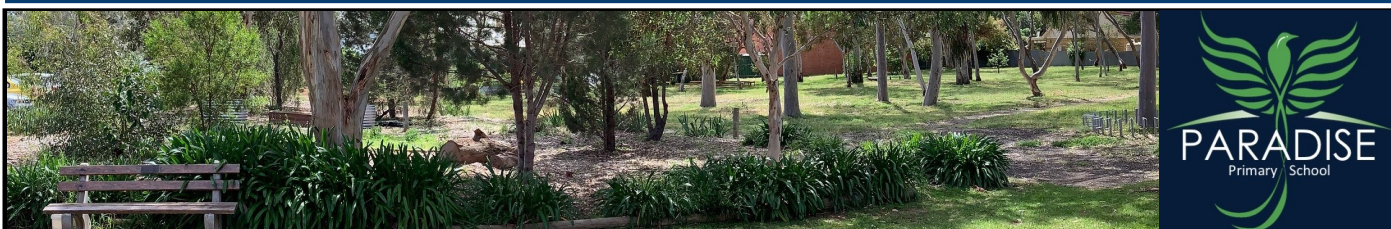
